Hundreds Club

Dear Parents/Guardians, School Staff and Governors,

Join the Therfield Hundreds Club – spend a pound or two a month and your chances of winning are much better than the National Lottery!

As well as having a chance to win one of four monthly cash prizes, you will be helping to raise money for Therfield School. Just purchase shares at £1 each and your number goes into a monthly draw. Of each £100 raised, £40 is handed out in prize money and £60 goes to the School Trust to purchase items the school needs but can't afford from its budget. In recent years these have included contributions to the sports college bid, the school merits vouchers, DT materials, hall redecoration and sound system and a school mini bus - to mention just a few.

Please join the club and make a difference to the school facilities as well as having a chance each month to win a cash prize. The more shares we sell, the bigger the prizes are!

Shares can be bought by Standing Order, cheque or cash: monthly £1 shares to a maximum of £10 a month. A **Standing Order form** is overleaf, or is available on the school website, along with the club rules (www.therfield.surrey.sch.uk home page – Social Team - or under Community – Trust Social Team). The names of winners are detailed each month on the school website and the cheque will be in the post.

Our target is to at least double the number of shares we sell which would make the top prize £60 and would make an annual contribution to the school of over £3000! Please help us achieve this.

If you are already a member of the 100s club (as at February that is only 68 participants buying 213 shares) and you would like to change the number of monthly shares you purchase you can do so at any time and we will change your number of counters in the draw.

Good luck and thank you for joining – you will be making a much appreciated contribution to Therfield School.

1. WHAT IS THE HUNDREDS CLUB?

The Therfield Hundreds Club is a scheme to raise funds for the benefit of all pupils of Therfield School

2. HOW DO I JOIN?

Fill in the Therfield Hundreds Club application form on the website and return it with the standing order authority completed – or if you prefer, with your cheque or cash payment – to Caroline Smith, Therfield Hundreds Club, c/o Therfield School Office.

3. HOW MUCH DO I PAY?

The annual subscription is a minimum of £12 representing 12 monthly payments of £1 up to a maximum of £120 a year representing 12 monthly payments of £10.

4. HOW DO I PAY?

Either by standing order – paying monthly, six monthly or annually, or by cheque or cash – six monthly or annually.

5. HOW DOES IT WORK?

The names of all paid up members enter a monthly draw for four cash prizes. If you pay, for example, £1 a month you get one entry in each monthly draw. If you pay £3 a month you get 3 entries etc. up to a maximum of £10 a month getting 10 entries in each monthly draw. Obviously, the higher your monthly contribution is the greater your chance of winning.

6. HOW MUCH CAN I WIN?

This depends on how many enter and how much they spend. For example, if 150 members each paid £2 a month, the monthly income would be £300. Of this, £180 (60%) goes to the school and £120 is paid out in prize money - 1st prize: £42, 2nd: £36, 3rd: £30 and 4th prize: £12.

7. HOW MUCH WILL THE SCHOOL BENEFIT IN A YEAR?

In the above example the school would get £2,160 to spend on extras needed in the year. £1440 would be paid out in prize money.

8. STANDING ORDERS

Please return the completed standing order form to Caroline Smith, Therfield Hundreds Club, via the School Office. Please do not forward it directly to your bank or building society.

9. CHEQUES AND CASH

Please make cheques payable to the Therfield Hundreds Club.

RULES OF THE THERFIELD HUNDREDS CLUB

1. The Club shall be known as the **THERFIELD HUNDREDS CLUB**
2. Membership shall be restricted to:
 - a) Members of the Therfield School Trust
 - b) All parents of past and present pupils attending Therfield School
 - c) School Governors and Staff
 - d) Former pupils of Therfield School
3. Membership shall be established by the purchase of a minimum of one share at £1 per month.
4. Members may hold up to a maximum of 10 shares (i.e. no more than £120 per annum).
5. The percentage of income distributed in prizes shall be at the discretion of the organizing committee but at no time will the total value of the prizes fall below 40% of the total income.
6. All paid up members shall be entered for each month's draw according to their shareholding.
7. Draws will take place monthly and be witnessed by at least five persons.
8. Income over and above the prize money and nominal administrative expenses shall be paid over to the main Therfield School Trust.
9. The club shall be managed by an organizing committee numbering not less than 5 members of the club.
10. For all other matters the Club will be subject to the overall rules of the Therfield School Trust as set out in its constitution.
